Travel Itinerary in Detail

Day 1: Mathura Sightseeing



Start your spiritual journey in Mathura, the city where Lord Krishna was born.

- Visit the Shri Krishna Janmabhoomi Temple Complex. This revered site is believed to be the exact prison cell where Lord Krishna was born.
- From the Janmabhoomi, head to the nearby Dwarkadhish Temple. This is one of Mathura's most important temples and is known for its intricate carvings and exquisite architecture.
- Mathura Birla Mandir was built by Jugal Kishore Birla in memory of his parents and the entire Bhagavad Gita which is inscribed on the pillars of the temple. This large temple is built of red sandstone and is considered as a product of skilled craftsmanship. The marble walls hold paintings of gods and goddesses.
- Bhuteshwar Mahadev temple, according to the beliefs of people in Mathura, Bhuteshwar Mahadev shields the city from evil.
- Dhruv Tila, a small hill situated at the actual place where Dhruva Maharaja had performed severe austerities to please the Supreme Lord in Satya Yuga.
- Madhuban is one of the famous 12 forests of Braj. In Satyuga, Lord Hari killed a demon named Madhu here. Because of this, He became known as Madhusudan. Therefore, this forest is named Madhuvan.
- End your day at Vishram Ghat, a holy bathing ghat on the banks of the Yamuna River, witness the evening aarti (a religious ritual involving light), which offers a truly spiritual and mesmerizing experience. Some people visit the ghat before going to the temple to have the holy bath.

Day 2: Gokul Sightseeing



- Visit Yogmaya Temple, associated with the birthplace of Yogmaya Devi. It is also believed to be the place where Lord Krishna and Yogmaya were born as twins.
- Raman Reti, the sacred sandy area where Krishna played with his brother Balarama and his cowherd friends. The compound also includes a temple and a deer sanctuary. Adjacent to it is the Karshni Ashram and the Raman Bihariji Temple.
- Chaurasi Khamba Temple located within Nand Bhawan, this mysterious temple features 84 pillars, but is said to be impossible to count correctly. Pilgrims believe that the number 84 represents the 84 lakh (8.4 million) species of life.
- Brahmand Ghat on the banks of the Yamuna River where Krishna is said to have revealed the entire universe (brahmand) in his mouth to Yashoda.
- Chinta Haran Mahadev near Brahmand Ghat, is believed to relieve devotees of their worries and grant them inner peace.
- Raval, the birthplace of Srimati Radharani.
- Dauji Maharaj, Lord Balram, also known as Dauji, was born to Mother Rohini eight days before Shri Krishna's birth. The village was originally called Ridha but is now known as Dauji in honor of the temple's presiding deity. Inside the temple, you'll find a striking black idol of Lord Balram, standing at about 7 feet tall.
- Bheel Van Lakshmi Ji or Belvan, It is believed that Goddess Lakshmi still resides in Belvan and worships Krishna.
- If time permits, visit Nand Bhawan also known as Nand Mahal.

Day 3: Vrindavan Sightseeing



- Visit Rangji Mandir, embracing Architectural Diversity. The Ramgji Temple stands out for its unique architectural style, showcasing a blend of elements from North Indian and South Indian temple architecture. The exterior walls, constructed from red sandstone, are adorned with intricate floral and geometric carvings.
- Nidhiva (chir Ghat), a sacred spot in Vrindavan on the bank of the Yamuna River famous for Lord Krishna's divine play (lila) of stealing the clothes (chir haran) of the gopis.
- Banke Bihari Temple, a highly revered temple. The unique idol of Lord Krishna is a major pilgrimage site, and the atmosphere is vibrant with devotion.
- ISKCON Vrindavan (Krishna Balaram Mandir). Experience the serene beauty and peaceful ambiance of this temple. Founded in 1975, the temple is known for its immaculate architecture and beautiful gardens. Time your visit for the captivating afternoon aarti (ritual of light).
- Prem Mandir, founded by Jagadguru Shri Kripalu Ji Maharaj in Vrindavan. The temple is especially beautiful in the evening when it is illuminated with colorful lights that change throughout the night.

- Chandra Uday Mandir, envisioned as the world's tallest religious structure, the Vrindavan Chandrodaya Mandir (VCM) aims to be more than merely a building - it seeks to serve as a symbol of devotion.
- Char Dham Mandir, the heart of Vrindavan, where divinity and serenity come together!, for those seeking peace, blessings, and spiritual connection.
- If time permits, visit Radha Raman Temple, one of Vrindavan's oldest and most historically significant temples. Built in 1542, it houses a self-manifested idol of Radha Raman and offers a glimpse into the region's rich history, walk to Keshi Ghat on the banks of the Yamuna River to witness a peaceful and spiritual evening aarti. Taking a boat ride on the river during sunset is also a serene experience.

Day 4: Barsana and Nandgaon Sightseeing



- Visit Radha Rani Temple dedicated to Radha, known for its architecture and spiritual atmosphere. Allow about 1.5 hours.
- Optionally, visit Kirti Mandir which is a short visit and often on the way.
- Proceed to Nandgaon, explore the main temple Nand Bhavan, which is central to the Krishna and Nanda legends.
- Kokila ban, is the place where the famous Shani Dev Temple is situated. This is a very ancient temple of Shani Dev and his guru Barkhandi baba.
- Asheshwar Mahadev, a famous temple dedicated to Lord Shiva.
- If time permits, visit Nandisvara Hill which is the site of Nandgaon, where Krishna spent his childhood and Gopal Mandir to see the sunset, which is a popular spot.

Day 5: Radha Rani Sightseeing



- Visit VanshiVat or Bansi vat temple, is where Radha Krishna appeared under a Vat tree where Krishna played flute, and is a holy place for MahaRaas.
- Maansarovar, is a divine lake, a wetland grove and bird sanctuary, where Radha came when annoyed by Krishna. It's a big, deep lake with a temple.
- Bhandirvan, a sacred forest in the Braj region of India, near Vrindavan, famous as the site where the divine wedding of Radha and Krishna took place, officiated by Lord Brahma. It is one of the 12 holy forests of Braj and is associated with many of Krishna's childhood stories, including his battle with the demon Pralambhasura.

Day 6: Chardham Temple



• Visit local "Chardham" that can be completed within a day. A large, modern Char Dham temple complex with a large Shiva statue also exists. Have Gangotri, Yamunotri, Badrinath and Kedar Nath Darshan in Brij Dham.

Day 7: Goverdhan Sightseeing



- Visit Daan Ghati Mandir: A temple where the Gowardhan parikrama often begins.
- Kusum Sarovar, another beautiful and historical water body surrounded by chhatris (cenotaphs).
- Mukharvind of Shrinathji, a revered site believed to be the face of Lord Krishna.
- Jatipura, located on the west side of Giriraj Govardhan, is a historic town with deep spiritual roots.
- Radha Kund and Shyam Kund, two important sacred ponds related to Radha and Krishna, located along the parikrama path.
- Mukharai village, named after Radharani's grandmother, Mukhara, who arranged meetings between Radha and Krishna. It has a temple and a bhajana-shila.
