Travel Itinerary in Detail.

Day 1: Arrival in Jaipur and Sightseeing.



- Arrive to Jaipur by air/train. Check-in into the hotel, get fresh and rest a while.
- Visit Amer Fort, the magnificent Amber Fort is perched atop a hill overlooking Maota Lake.
- The City Palace, a royal residence and former administrative headquarters of the rulers of the Jaipur State. Construction started soon after the establishment of the city of Jaipur under the reign of Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, who moved his court to Jaipur from Amber, in 1727.
- The Hawa Mahal is a palace in the city. Built from red and pink sandstone, it is on the edge of the City Palace, and extends to the Zenana, or women's chambers. Hawa Mahal also known as the "palace of winds" was built in 1799 by Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh.
- Jal Mahal or "Water Palace" is a historic palace, located in the middle of Man Sagar Lake, built in the early 18th century from pink sandstone, it features five stories, with four submerged when the lake is full, creating the illusion of floating on water. While entry to the palace is restricted, visitors can view it from the pathway around the lake.
- The Jantar Mantar is a collection of 19 astronomical instruments built by the Rajput king Sawai Jai Singh, the founder of Jaipur. The monument was completed in 1734. It features the world's largest stone sundial, and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is near City Palace and Hawa Mahal.
- Jaipur was painted pink in 1876 to welcome Prince Albert, who nicknamed it 'Pink City'.

Day 2: Jaipur Sightseeing



- Nahargarh Fort stands on the edge of the Aravalli Hills, overlooking the city.
- Jaigarh Fort is situated on the promontory called the Cheel ka Teela (Hill of Eagles) of the Aravalli range; it overlooks the Amer Fort and the Maota Lake
- Birla Mandir, also known as the Lakshmi Narayan Temple, is a stunning white marble temple in Jaipur built in 1988 by the Birla family. Dedicated to Lord Vishnu and Goddess Lakshmi, it is located at the base of Moti Dungri and is famous for its intricate carvings and architectural beauty.
- Patrika Gate is a famous landmark in Pink City, Jaipur and one of the biggest circle parks in Asia. Patrika Gate was built in 2016 by the Patrika Group.
- The Vidhan Bhavan is the seat of the Rajasthan Legislative Assembly. It is one of the most modern legislature complexes in India. It is situated in Jyoti Nagar, the capital of the state.

Day 3: : Khatushyam Maharaj Darshan and Bikaner Sightseeing



- After breakfast, proceed to Khatu Shyam Maharaj Darsh at Khatu Village.
- Reach Khatu Village and have the blessing of Khatu Shyam Maharaj.
- En route visit Rat Temple (Karni Mata Temple) at Deshnok.
- If interested and time permits, you can visit spiritual sites like Salasar Balaji Temple and Jeen Mata Temple, which are close to Khatu Shyam, and natural attractions like Tal Chhapar Sanctuary. You can also see historic forts such as Laxmangarh Fort and Devgarh Fort. Check with the driver if it is possible to cover.

Day 4: Jaisalmer Road Trip and Sightseeing



- After Breakfast, visit Junagarsh Fort, a historic fortress known for its grand architecture and opulent palaces.
- Lallgarh Palace, a palace and heritage hotel in Bikaner, in the Indian state of Rajasthan, built for Sir Ganga Singh, Maharaja of Bikaner, between 1902 and 1926.
- Camel Breeding Farm (Optional), the farm offers guided tours, camel rides, camel milk tasting, and a souvenir shop, providing a unique experience into camel breeding and desert culture. The camel farm maintains an elite herd of more than 300 camels of Bikaneri, Jaisalmeri, Kachchhi and Mewari breeds.
- Late Drive to Jaisalmer- The Golden City,
- Evening Arrival and check-in at Hotel. Overnight stay at Jaisalmer.

Day 5: Jaisalmer Sightseeing and Camp



- Start your day by visiting Patwon ki Haveli is a cluster of five small havelis, commissioned in 1805 by Guman Chand Patwa, a wealthy trader.
- Jalim/Salim Singh ki Haveli was built in 1815 CE by Salim Singh, the then Prime Minister of the kingdom when Jaisalmer was the capital.
- Gadisar Lake is an artificial lake, built by the founder of Jaisalmer, Rawal Jaisal Bhati in 1156 AD and later rebuilt by his successor Rawal Gadsji Bhati around 1367 AD.
- Overnight stay at Jailsermer Desert Camp.

Day 06: Jaisalmer Sightseeing and Road Trip To Jodhpur



- Checkout from the Desert Camp and visit below popular places if interested and time permitted.
- Longewala is a border town located in the Thar Desert about 111 km from the city of Jaisalmer.
- Tanot Mata Mandir, a temple famous for its association with the Battle of Longewala in the Indo-Pakistani War of 1971. Located near the Pakistan border, it is known for having withstood thousands of bombs during the 1965 and 1971 wars, with many unexploded bombs now displayed inside the temple. The area also features the Longewala War Memorial and a war museum.
- The Indo-Pak border near Jaisalmer is a significant and heavily monitored frontier between India and Pakistan, located in the Thar Desert.
- Kuldhara is an abandoned village, established around the 13th century.
- Bada Bagh, also called Barabagh "grand garden" is a garden complex.
- The Golden Fort in Jaisalmer, also known as Sonar Qila, is a historic "living fort", built in 1156 CE by King Rawal Jaisal.
- Evening Proceed to Jodhpur (4h 35m (266 km). Start your journey early to Jodhpur on time.

- Visit Jaswant Thada, a cenotaph located in Jodhpur, in the Indian state of Rajasthan. It was built by Maharaja Sardar Singh of Jodhpur State in 1899.
- The Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum is a part of the larger palace complex that was built between 1928 and 1943.
- Proceed Journey to Mount Abu.

Day 08: Mount Abu Sightseeing and Road Trip to Udaipur



- After breakfast, visit Dilwara Temple Complex, these temples dating back to the twelfth and thirteenth century are reflective of the Gujarat dynasty and civilization.
- Achalgarh Fort is a brilliant example of how several religions and dynasties came together in Mount Abu and Rajasthan as a whole, to give it a texture and social-political history of its own.
- Trevor's Tank and Toad Rock, the stone is naturally shaped like a frog about to jump in the water and hence it is called so. What is even more spectacular is the breathtaking view of the Aravalli ranges and the rest of Mount Abu that it offers.
- Honeymoon Point, the place is also often known as Anadara point and is popular among couples and families alike for the majestic views it offers of the lake and the old gateway to Mount Abu.
- Enjoy the sunset point at Nakki Lake and proceed to Udaipur (3 hr 13 min (163.7 km), plan your day accordingly.

Day 9: Udaipur Sightseeing.



- Visit Moti Magri, or "Pearl Hill," is a hill in Udaipur that overlooks Fateh Sagar Lake and features the Maharana Pratap Memorial.
- Fateh Sagar Lake is an artificial lake named after Maharana Fateh Singh of Udaipur and Mewar, constructed north-west of Udaipur, to the north of Lake Pichola in the 1680s.
- Nehru Garden is a landscaped island garden in Fateh Sagar Lake showcasing diverse plants, trees & bird life.
- Saheliyon-ki-Bari is a major garden and a popular tourist space having fountains and kiosks, a lotus pool and marble elephants. It was built by Rana Sangram Singh.

DAY 10: Udaypur Sightseeing



- Visit City Palace, built over a period of nearly 400 years, with contributions from several rulers of the Mewar dynasty.
- The Maharana Pratap Museum Udaipur displays a curated collection of historic artifacts, paintings, and weaponry that illustrate the life and times of the legendary king.
- Bharatiya Lok Kala Mandal is a cultural institution engaged in studying folk art, culture, songs and festivals.
- Bagore-ki-Haveli is right on the waterfront of Lake Pichola at Gangori Ghat. Amar Chand Badwa, a Prime Minister of Mewar, built it in the eighteenth century.
- Gangaur Ghat or Gangori Ghat is a main ghat situated near the waterfront of Lake Pichola near Bagore Ki Haveli.
- Ambrai Ghat or Manjhi Ghat and Hanuman Ghat is also a main ghat situated near the waterfront of Lake Pichola opposite to the Gangaur Ghat.
- Drop will be provided to Udaipur station. Conclude your trip here with great memories of this royal state.
