Travel Itinerary in Detail.

Day 1: Arrival in Jaipur and Sightseeing.



- Arrive to Jaipur by air/train. Check-in into the hotel, get fresh and have a rest while.
- Visit Amer Fort, the magnificent Amber Fort is perched atop a hill overlooking Maota Lake.
- The City Palace, a royal residence and former administrative headquarters of the rulers of the Jaipur State. Construction started soon after the establishment of the city of Jaipur under the reign of Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, who moved his court to Jaipur from Amber, in 1727.
- The Hawa Mahal is a palace in the city. Built from red and pink sandstone, it is on the edge of the City Palace, and extends to the Zenana, or women's chambers. Hawa Mahal also known as the "palace of winds" was built in 1799 by Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh.
- Jal Mahal, or "Water Palace," is a historic palace, located in the middle of Man Sagar Lake. Built in the early 18th century from pink sandstone, it features five stories, with four submerged when the lake is full, creating the illusion of floating on water. While entry to the palace is restricted, visitors can view it from the pathway around the lake.
- The Jantar Mantar is a collection of 19 astronomical instruments built by the Rajput king Sawai Jai Singh, the founder of Jaipur. The monument was completed in 1734. It features the world's largest stone sundial, and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is near City Palace and Hawa Mahal.
- Jaipur was painted pink in 1876 to welcome Prince Albert, who nicknamed it 'Pink City'. A law in 1877 mandated future buildings be pink.



DAY 2: Jaipur Sightseeing



- Nahargarh Fort stands on the edge of the Aravalli Hills, overlooking the city.
- Jaigarh Fort is situated on the promontory called the Chheel ka Teela (Hill of Eagles) of the Aravalli range; it overlooks the Amer Fort and the Maota Lake
- Birla Mandir, also known as the Lakshmi Narayan Temple, is a stunning white marble temple in Jaipur built in 1988 by the Birla family. Dedicated to Lord Vishnu and Goddess Lakshmi, it is located at the base of Moti Dungri and is famous for its intricate carvings and architectural beauty.
- Patrika Gate is a famous landmark in Pink City, Jaipur and one of the biggest circle parks in Asia. Patrika Gate was built in 2016 by the Patrika Group.
- The Vidhan Bhavan is the seat of the Rajasthan Legislative Assembly. It is one of the most modern legislature complexes in India. It is situated in Jyoti Nagar, the capital of the state.

Day 3: Ranthambore Jungle Safari



- After breakfast, check out from the Jaipur hotel and drive to the Ranthambore. It is 180 km away from Jaipur and it will take approximately 3.5 hrs of road drive.
- Have a thrilling safari adventure through Ranthambore National Park, experiencing the raw wilderness and potential for spotting iconic wildlife, as many visitors have described it as a magical encounter with nature.
- Ranthambore Fort lies within the Ranthambore National Park, near the city of Sawai Madhopur in Sawai Madhopur district.
- The Trinetra Ganesh Temple is situated inside the Ranthambore Fort, and is famous as one of the oldest temples. It is the only temple in the entire world which houses the entire family of Lord Ganesha while his statue consists of three eyes.

Day 4: Pushkar Tirth



- Proceed to Pushkar which is 315 km away from Ranthambore. It will take approximately 6 hours to reach.
- Pushkar Tirth is a holy site, centered around the sacred Pushkar Lake and the only major Brahma Temple in the world. It is considered one of the five most sacred pilgrimage sites in Hinduism and is famous for its annual fair and the belief that a dip in the lake can cleanse one of sins. The site's importance comes from the myth that the lake was created from a lotus that fell from Brahma's hand during a sacred ritual (yajna).
- If time permits, Savitri Mata Temple situated on Ratnagiri hill, this temple is dedicated to Brahma's wife, Savitri, and is a popular pilgrimage site.

Day 5: Conclude the trip to Jaipur



- Checkout from the hotel and proceed to Jaipur. If time permits, you can visit the site below on the way.
- The Dumping Yard Kishangarh is a unique marble slurry dump yard, free to enter with a token, open 10 AM to 6 PM.
- The Ajmer Dargah, also known as the Ajmer Sharif Dargah, is a renowned Sufi shrine in Ajmer, dedicated to the saint Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti. It is considered one of India's holiest Muslim pilgrimage sites and attracts a vast number of tourists and devotees from around the world. The complex features the saint's tomb, the Akbari Mosque, and other structures made of white marble.
- Drop will be provided to Jaipur Station/Airport.
